Summer Mission Trip July 11-17

Rosebud Reservation, SD

Cost=\$240 per person

The Rosebud Reservation is home to the Sicangu Lakota Tetunwan Oyate band of Sioux, located in south central South Dakota. We will discover the rich culture and heritage of this tribe, but we will also find residents who are in desperate situations due to unemployment, poverty and homelessness. We will have many opportunities to serve through children's ministries and home improvement projects. High unemployment (85 percent), poverty and understaffed health care facilities all have contributed to the problem of rising suicide. An estimated one out of three residents on the reservation is homeless, and six out of ten live in substandard housing. These challenges present an obvious invitation to reach out and support this community with your ministry.

We will leave Sunday morning July 11th and travel to the Youthworks mission site on the Rosebud Reservation in South Dakota. We will serve on the reservation throughout the week.

All meals are covered while we are at the mission site but meals to and from the site will need to be covered by each individual.

We are still working on an activity on the return trip home. We are looking into going tubing down the Niobrara River. The cost of the activity is included in the cost of the trip.

We will break the cost of the trip up into 3 payments of \$80.

First payment will be due in March, second payment in April, and the third in June.

We need students to sign up by January 24th to reserve their spot.
