## 1 WEARING MASKS

We believe wearing masks will make a good-faith effort to help keep others safe during this health crisis. We will be asking all teachers and students Kindergarten and older to wear a mask at programming whenever 6 feet of social distancing is not possible, whether in the hallways or the classrooms. We also ask that the adult dropping off and picking up children wear a mask in the hallways. Masks are recommended, but not required for ages 3- Pre-K.




## 2 HANDWASHING & CLEANING PROCEDURES

All students and teachers will be asked to wash or sanitize their hands upon entering the classroom and throughout programming as needed. Extra cleaning procedures have been put into place throughout our facility.



## 3 LIMITING CLASS SIZES | ONLINE REGISTRATION\*

We will be following the CDC guidelines to limit class sizes for programming this fall. In order to help us do this, we will be requiring pre-registration for participation in all Wednesday Night Live programming. Registration is not required for Sunday School classes at this time.



## 4 SOCIAL DISTANCING IN HALLWAYS

To promote social distancing, we ask that only one parent drop off students in their classrooms for programming. We will have the main hallway loop in the education wing labeled for one-way travel to help prevent congregating before and after class. We ask that adults wear a mask when in the education wing.



## 5 CLASSES WILL STAY TOGETHER | NO TRAVELING

In an attempt to limit exposure, we will have students stay with their own group in their classroom (no gathering in large groups, no traveling for music time, etc.) Worship and singing time will happen in individual classrooms. The youth ministries will not gather all-together, but will stay in their respective ministry areas.



## 6 STOP THE SPREAD | STAY HOME IF YOU ARE UNWELL

If anyone in your household is sick, has a fever, or has been asked to quarantine, we ask that you stay home as a way to show care for all the other students and teachers. We will not be doing temperature checks of everyone at the doors. In the event someone does not appear to be feeling well, we will have a thermometer available. If a student has a fever, they will be removed from the classroom and parents will be called to pick up immediately.
